Description:

In this course, some of the activities include:

- Camping overnight at the Heart of the Outdoors, may include 3D archery, canoeing, paintball, etc.
- Hiking
- Learning how to fly-fish (including a full day with professional guide at Brookville Lake and a starter set rod, reel, flies, etc.
- Self-defense basics (hand-to-hand)
- DIY/handyman skills

A service element will be included in this course; it will include some form of manual labor utilizing new skills learned. Due to the diverse range of activities, each day's schedule will differ. Please note that the overnight camping days are only part of this course, on the other days of Intercession most activities will take place in a 9:00 a.m.-3:00 p.m. timeframe with students returning to school each day. This is a normal 8 day Intercession.

This course is well suited to: Any male student at CHCA that has a desire to learn new skills, has a growth mindset, and wants to help others. This could be a great option for spring athletes that need to stay local.

Cost: \$700

Additional costs: Students will need camping gear (sleeping bags, tent, etc.), regular fishing gear (possible to rent what is needed), appropriate shoes and clothing for hiking. Application fee for fishing license (\$19). Packed lunches on some days
